

STAMPA 2019 POSTMARKS



Friday 11th October: The postmark marks the 100th anniversary of the first non-stop transatlantic flight by John Alcock and Arthur Whitten Brown who landed in Clifden, Co. Galway on 15 June 1919. The postmark shows a front on view of their Vickers Vimy plane. The matching stamp is the Alcock & Brown stamp issued on 13th June by An Post.

Saturday 12th October: The postmark shows a Rugby Ball and marks Ireland's participation in the Rugby World Cup in Japan. On the day Ireland will be playing Samoa in their final pool game. An Post issued two stamps earlier this year showing the Irish team captain Johnny Sexton and the team manager Joe Schmidt.

Sunday 13th October: The postmark shows the outline of a Roseate Tern which is shown on one of the Europa stamps on the theme of National Birds issued earlier this year.
